

Over the years, we have been asked on many occasions, "Why don't you just help people here in the U.S.? There are many needs here!" And while that is certainly true, a day on a mission trip to Mexico, many years ago, might explain why we are doing this particular work:

Wayne and I were on a mission trip, fresh out of Bible College, with a group called Joshua's Army. We were in the state of Chihuahua City, in central Mexico. On one of our last days out, the team decided to do a little mountain climbing, just for fun. The climbing of the mountain, ended up being far more difficult than any of us could have grasped. As we reached the top of the mountain, we all sat down, gasping for air. Suddenly, over the other side of the mountain, a man appeared. He also, had been hiking up to the summit. As the man arrived to the top, our group said hello, and started chatting with him. By the time our group had to leave, this man received prayer and had given his life to the Lord!!

On the way up the mountain, as it was so very difficult to climb, I began asking myself, why in the world we had decided to do this. It made no sense, really!! Afterwards, as we arrived back to our camp that night, the Lord began to speak to me. He told me that the world, to HIM, is as small as a postage stamp. And to Him, sending us several thousand miles away, to lead someone to Jesus, was no big deal. It made perfect sense in the way that GOD thinks about things. And so, when asked why we do this work in Mexico, or why we do

Though, I (Wayne) do not usually pay too much attention to those who want to inquire about why I (or why I shouldn't) take food to people in Mexico, I think, along with Autumn and her illustration above, Keith Green says it best in the lyrics of his song "Sheep and the goats".
