Of course, this is an added expense to our budget, but very necessary with the recent busyness of the ministry. We collect food 7 days a week now, and are loading trucks bound for TJ, 4 days a week. Between our partner Greg, and Wayne, over 20,000 lbs of food per week, are transported across the border!

We helped with her high school enrollment, as there are costs at that level of schooling in Mexico. In addition to some recent car repairs, we are also supporting this family monthly, with the normal income that Carlos would have provided.
